In the second part, a multi-storey timber building under construction will be visited - using durable timber-products and relying on the latest building technology as a contribution against climate change. The forestry board will invite you to enjoy a snack at a place on the building site.

The starting point and destination is the German Railways stop »UN Campus«. This is located at the junction of Genscherallee and Joseph-Beuys-Allee (city bus stop »Walter-Flex-Straße«) and is about ten minutes' walk from United Nations Square/WCCB or there is scheduled shuttle bus service every 15 minutes.
